- NO ENTRY FEE, NO REQUIREMENT TO BRING BASEBALLS
- Four game guarantee (Weather Permitting)
- Seven inning games
- Coin flip to determine home team
- Mandan will always be home team and be in 3rd Base Dugout
- Lineup cards should be in the press box 30 minutes prior to game
- Pre-game infield allowed for each teams' first game of the day
 - o If time allows teams that do not play back-to-back may take a 2nd infield
 - All rules will be governed by the American Legion rulebook
 - o NO COURTESY RUNNERS ALLOWED
 - o DH only for the pitcher
 - o No Re-Entry
 - o 10 Run Rule after 5 innings
 - o Coaches must wear protective helmets per American Legion Rules
- Tournament Champion will be determined by overall record

Tie-Breaker System

- 1) Head to Head
- 2) Least Runs Allowed
- 3) Most Runs Scored
- 4) Coin flip

Skills Competition (8:15 pm on Saturday)

Speed Kills

- -one member from each team can participate
- -everyone has one opportunity at each area
- -total time is used = lowest time is the winner
- -3 Runs (Home to First, Second to Home, First to Home)

Sniper

- -two members from each team participate
- -three throws from center field aiming at garbage can tipped over on home plate

Coaches Challenge

- -one coach per team
- -pop flies into the "triangles" behind 1b, 2b, and 3b
- -Closest to the Pin on the fly in centerfield
- -Catcher pop up (based on air time and landing from home plate circle to backstop)

Home Run Derby

- -two players per team
- -ten outs per round
- -HRs do not count against hitter (like the MLB Home Run Derby)
- -Finals between top 2 HR hitters

Tournament Rules

- Home teams: All Omaha host teams (hosts) will be home team for their games during pool play. All other
 pool play games home team determined by coin flip. All championship bracket games home team
 determined by coin flip.
- 7-inning games, 10-run rule after 5 innings (4 1/2 if home team is ahead). No time limit, however, we reserve the right to utilize a 2-hour time limit if games fall behind schedule due to rain. In the event of weather issues, 5 innings (4 1/2 if home team is ahead) will be considered an official game. A game that does not complete 5 innings or is tied at the time of suspension will play by suspended rules picked up from the point of suspension.
- American League DH rule (DH for pitcher only).
- Courtesy runner (optional) allowed for pitcher & catcher. Must be a previously unused player.
- Re-entry allowed one time for starters only.
- Bat Rule: All bats must be BBCOR stamped or wood. Any player found using an illegal bat will be immediately called out.
- All other regular season American Legion rules apply.
- The following criteria (in order) will be used to determine pool play finish: pool play record, head-to-head result, least runs allowed in all games, run differential in all games, coin flip
