




With the nucleus back from last years team this should be a very successful year for Legion baseball in Bismarck.

ROB MONTGOMERY, coach









BISMARCK AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL

The Bismarck 1980 American Legion program will consist of three teams: the "AA" squad will play a forty-five to fifty-five game schedule. It will include once again participation in four tournaments during the regular season, two of those will be in Bismarck. Road trips are planned to South Dakota, Montana, Wyoming, and eastern North Dakota. Post season play will be the Western Division Tournament in Minot, North Dakota and the State Tournament in Bismarck. The regional tournament that the state champion will participate in will be in Fenton, Missouri. The World Series is in Ely, Minnesota. The 1980 "AA" All-Star game is also slated for Bismarck July 13th at 1:30 o'clock.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The top two finishers in the "AA" tournaments and the top finishers of four class "A" tournaments meet in a State Tournament to decide the State Champion. The Champion then enters a Regional Tournament against the South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri Champions and a host team. The winner of this tournament advances to a National Tournament to determine the National Champion.

This season, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program will again sponsor two "A" teams, the Royals and Scarlets. Each squad will consist of 15-18 players in the 14-16 year age bracket. Each team will play approximately 35 games with practices beginning the middle of May and the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a district tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day games are not scheduled. The Royals practice time is 12:30 p.m. and the Scarlets practice time is 10:00 a.m. or 4:00 p.m. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

Each team member will be provided with a uniform,

jacket and carrying bag. The players will need to furnish their own gloves, shoes, and personal equipment.

We welcome all players of this age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to a better caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the 2-team concept will not require us to cut anyone from the program who has the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.

The past two years the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program has been financed by the Bismarck Legion Club, that donates a substantial sum of money for this program, and by concerned businesses in the Bismarck-Mandan area. This financial assistance has enabled the Bismarck Legion Committee to administer a fine program.

This program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing and opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the game of baseball like they never knew it before, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball program along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsor the Bismarck Rookie League.

Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop the baseball skills that will allow these young people to enjoy and understand the game so as to become better participants and spectators.

The league consists basically of persons who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Rookie League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop the baseball skill of the players.

Coaches for Rookie League teams are volunteer adults who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.
