



# Bismarck American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck 1985 American Legion Baseball Program will consist of three teams. The Governors, Royals and Scarlets. Our goal in 1985 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The Governors, our "AA" varsity team, will play about a 60-game schedule. Post-season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Minot, and the State Tournament in Wahpeton, the 1985 "AA" All-Star game is slated in Bismarck, July 28th.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot and Williston. At the end of the regular season, each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The two top finishers from each division will meet in an "AA" Tournament and the four regional "A" winners will meet in an "A" Tournament. There will be two state champions declared in these tournaments that will be conducted in the same field and run simultaneously. The two winners will then meet in a best-of-three series at the site of the "AA" champions to declare an overall state champion that will advance to national playoffs. The champion then enters a Regional Tournament against the South Dakota. Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas and Missouri champions and a host team. The winner of this tournament advances to the American Legion World Series to determine the National Champion.

This season, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program will again sponsor two "A" teams the Royals and Scarlets. Each squad will consist of 15 players in the 14 to 16 year age bracket. Each team will play approximately thirty-five games with practices beginning the middle of May the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a district tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for family activities.

Weather permitting practices are held each day that games are not scheduled. The Royals practice time is 12:30 p.m. and the Scarlets practice time is 10:00 a.m. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

Each team member will be provided with a uniform, cap and carrying bag. The players furnish their own gloves, shoes, and personal equipment.

We welcome any interested youth between 13 and 16 years of age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to a high caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the two-team structure will allow any interested young man the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.


Historically, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program has been financed by the Bismarck Legion Club which donates a substantial portion of the costs of this program. The Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1 and its Athletic Committee are particularly grateful for the money, services and time donated by the many individuals, organizations, and businesses which is a vital part of funding this program.

This program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the fame of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program, along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsor the Bismarck Rookie League. Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop baseball skills to enable participants to become better players and fans.


The Rookie League consists of young athletes who have completed the 7th, 8th and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Rookie League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop their baseball skills.

Coaches for Rookie League teams are volunteer adults who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.

## David Wolf


#### **GOVERNORS COACH**

David Wolf is a native of Rolla, North Dakota. He participated in high school sports in Rolla and was a team member of Rolla's 1976 and 1979 State Class A American Legion Baseball championship teams.

David is a graduate of Mayville State College at Mayville, North Dakota. While at college, he was a member of Mayville State's football and baseball teams. He was the Comet's starting catcher all four of his years at Mayville State. In addition to numerous other awards earned during his outstanding college athletic career, he was elected the baseball team captain for his senior year and was elected all-conference catcher his sophmore, junior and senior years.

David's coaching career began with Little League Baseball at Rolla, North Dakota, during 1980. The summers of 1981, 1982 and 1983 he coached the American Legion Baseball team at Mobridge, South Dakota and led that team to the South Dakota Class B Championship in 1981. While at Mobridge, he also was in charge of the city's Little League and Midget Baseball programs. While at Mobridge, David also caught for the Mobridge Cardinals amateure baseball team which placed fourth in the State in 1983. David served as an assistant baseball coach at Mayville State College during the Spring of 1983 until his graduation from college.

During the 1984 baseball season, David coached the Willmar, Minnesota American Legion Baseball team to a second place finish in Minnesota and a seeding in the National Regional Tournament held at Rockport, Indiana. His 1984 team received the Minnesota Team Sportsmanship Award at the State Tournament.




## Wayne Horner GOVERNORS ASSISTANT COACH

Wayne was a member of the 1982 State Championship Team and during the 1983 season led the team in all offensive categories.





Charles is presently residing in the Harvey Nursing Home, Harvey, North Dakota 58341. He will appreciate hearing from you.


