Bismarck American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck 1991 American Legion Baseball Program will consist of three teams - the Governors, Royals, and Scarlets. Our goal in 1991 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The Governors, our "AA" varsity team, will play about a 55 game schedule. Post-season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Bismarck and the State Tournament in Jamestown.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season, each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The state champion then enters a Regional Tournament against South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, and Missouri champions and a host team. The winner of that tournament advances to the American Legion World Series to determine the National Champion.

This season the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program will again sponsor two "A" teams - the Scarlets and Royals. The Scarlets will consist of about 15 players in the 15 and 16 year age bracket, and will play approximately 50 games. The Royals will carry 14 to 18 players in the 14 to 15 year age bracket, and will play about 40 games. Practices begin the middle of May, with the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a district tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day that games are not scheduled. The Royals practice time is 12:30 p.m., and the Scarlets practice time is 10:00 a.m. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

We welcome any interested youth between 14 and 16 years of age to try out for this program. It is

an opportunity to be exposed to a high caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the two-team structure will allow any interested young man the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.


Historically, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program has been financed by the Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1, which donates a portion of the costs of the program. The Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1 and its Athletic Committee are particularly grateful for the money, services, and time donated by the many individuals, organizations, and businesses which is a vital part of funding this program.

The program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the game of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program, along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsors the Bismarck Babe Ruth Program. Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop baseball skills to enable participants to become better players and fans.

The Babe Ruth League consists of young athletes who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Babe Ruth League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop their baseball skills

Coaches for Babe Ruth League teams are people who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.

Coach Breuer is beginning his 23rd year as a coach in the Bismarck American Legion program. Al is a graduate of Wyndmere High School and North Dakota State, where he participated in varsity baseball and basketball. His Bismarck coached teams have won 500 games and lost 253. Last year's Governors team was Al's first at that level, and they finished with a 30-29 record and a 4th place finish in the state tournament.

For the 1987 season Coach Breuer was named runner-up for the North Dakota Amateur Baseball Coach of the Year Award by the United States Baseball Federation.

In Bismarck, Al teaches at Hughes Jr. High where he is the athletic director and also coaches football and basketball. Coach Breuer and his wife Karen are the parents of two children - Tana, who lives in Fargo and Jim, who will be a senior at Century High School.


GOVERNORS ASSISTANT COACH

SCARLETS COACH



He and his wife, LeAnn, reside at 3128 Manitoba Lane.



Each player is asked to participate by selling tickets and helping with the food service. Many of our parents also participate as evidenced by the pictures.



"I didn't know you were going to be upset because I couldn't become a star."


