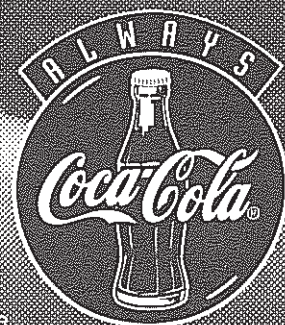

In Memory of *Duane Hummel*

1933-1994

Duane Hummel loved sports, but baseball was always at the top of his list. He grew up on Thayer and 15th Street, alternately chasing and slamming baseballs out of the yard or in pickup games around the neighborhood.

Duane idolized Ty Cobb, Babe Ruth, Joe Dimaggio, and Lou Gehrig. When he tried out for Bismarck's American Legion squad, he was intimidated by the older players. That'll happen to a 13-year-old.

He made the squad, but wasn't going to join the team. Supporters urged him on and his father, Matt, told him to "get on down there and give it a shot."

That was the spring of 1946. He played Legion ball through the 1951 season and later, in 1957, had a taste of pro ball as the catcher of the Bismarck Barons. He passed on the Big League and an offer from the Cleveland Indians. He loved to tell people he took his Dad's advice and finished college instead.

In 1958, Duane coached Bismarck's Legion team to the West Division championship. It was his only year as the Bismarck coach.

But his involvement and support for baseball, Legion baseball in particular, went on for decades. He served on Bismarck's Legion baseball committee from 1989 until his death.

Duane's brother, Dave, grew up watching his older brother the baseball player. "With Duane it was if you're there, you play your heart out. You're not there to waste time. You play to win but you play fair. You lose or win graciously. He was never one to flaunt a win and that's why throughout the years, the ones who competed against him respected him."

Duane made friends, hundreds of them, through baseball. Those friendships, Dave said, lasted the

years.

Long time Bismarck Tribune Sports Editor Abe Winter knew Duane well. "When the phone rang and Duane identified himself, I knew the conversation would be pleasant. Most of the time it would be regarding something our staff had written. His usually was the rare call applauding one of our stories, whether it was about one of his talented sons, or any other sports story that moved him."

Duane didn't always agree with the local sports press. "If he didn't agree, he'd tell us," Winter said, "but always in the same even tone."

Although he had a long sports career, Duane Hummel probably spent even more time with his children. In addition to his wife, Mary Ann, he is survived by Anne, Mike, Paul, Bill, Mark, and Dave. A daughter, Susan, died in 1967.

Except for a couple of years, at least one son was playing sports at St. Mary's from 1979 through 1992. "He had such a great knowledge of every game and that was one thing he imparted to us," said his son, Bill. "We'd be watching a game on TV and he'd be able to tell us what the offense was trying to do, what the quarterback was thinking."

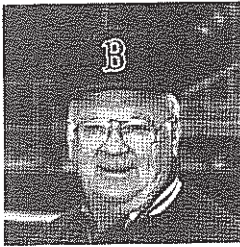
"Baseball really was his true love. That probably was the passion he passed onto us. He was the catcher and he understood the game so well."

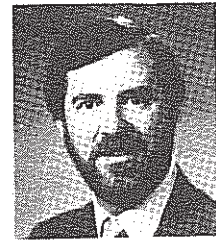

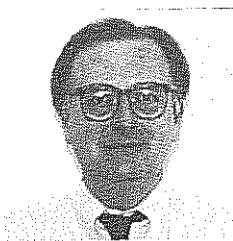

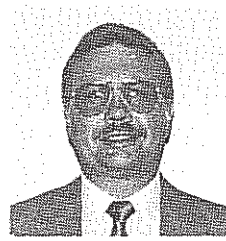

Bismarck Scarlets Roll to State Title

NEW ROCKFORD - In 15 summers of coaching the Bismarck Scarlets American Legion Baseball team, Gene Severson hasn't seen a better group of 16-year-old players than this year's set.

That says a lot about the group. Then again, the Scarlets showed a lot in running off 10 straight victories in district, regional and state Class B tournament play on their way to the state championship.

The crowning moment came Sunday as the Scarlets came from behind in the sixth inning for a 7-6 title victory over Enderlin.

A single, error and walk off Enderlin pitcher Cory Schall loaded the bases with no one out in the sixth for the Scarlets, who were down 6-4. Enderlin then called on Chris Schmitz, already with a win and save the tournament, to put out the fire.

But the move didn't pay off as Pat Laschen stroked a two-run single to tie the game. Cole Delmore followed with a sacrifice fly that plated Ky Saylor, who earlier walked to set up the bases-loaded situation, with what stood up as the game-winning run.

"I don't think this will sink in until the bus ride home," said an elated Laschen, who's the Scarlets' catcher.

"This is the best group I've has," Severson said. "We started off the district playing good baseball and it followed all the way through."

"Fifteen and 16-year-olds are often intimidated by 18-year-olds and this group wasn't," the coach added. "You could see that. Other kids would have folded under the pressure, but these kids didn't."

Enderlin didn't buckle either.

After an 18-3 first-round crushing Thursday at the hands of Napoleon, Enderlin won four consecutive games to get back into the title game. Along the way it beat Region A rival Lisbon, tournament-favorite Sawyer-Surrey and Napoleon.

The name of the game was revenge as Enderlin got back at Napoleon for the first-round loss and Surrey, which topped the team in last spring's state high school tournament.

Enderlin would have needed two victories over the unbeaten Scarlets for the Championship. Bismarck was 4-0 in the four-day event.

Still, coach Kevin Bratland was more than happy with his team's accomplishment.

"We were hoping to win maybe two, three games," he said. "But to get to this point was great. There's really nothing to be ashamed of. ...[The Scarlets] are an excellent group of 16-year-olds."

Bratland said there was no doubting his decision to go to Schmitz in the sixth-inning jam.

"He's been so consistant for us for two years," the coach said of the tournament most valuable player. "When I asked him if his arm was O.K. he said yes. He didn't bat an eye.

Of course he wouldn't have said no even if he was hurting."

But it wasn't meant to be Sunday.

With Enderlin down 7-6 in the top of the seventh, Barry Davidson led off with a single to left field. Any attempt at a rally was wiped out though when Laschen picked off Davidson at first after taking a pitch from Casey Heinert.

Heinert, on in relief of starter Todd Potter, did allow a two-out walk to Rod Hartl but he regrouped to retire Jason Schatzke on a flyout to right field.

"Our defense was superb-all the way through," Severson said. "We got good pitching and hitting was just good enough."

The Scarlets opened a 4-1 lead in the second on Enderlin starter Brady Opheim thanks to an RBI hit by Jason Breitzman along with run-scoring walks by Saylor and Laschen.

Enderlin came back for a 6-4 lead with four in the fifth. John Spiekermeier had a two-run triple, and Opheim and Schall added RBI hits.

Schmitz led the 10-hit attack with three hits. Opheim and Davidson added two hits apiece. Opheim, Schall and Spiekermeier each had two RBI.

Breitzman and Laschen led the Scarlets, who managed just five hits. Breitzman had two singles and Laschen three RBI.

The Scarlets finished 37-12 and Enderlin ended at 34-8.

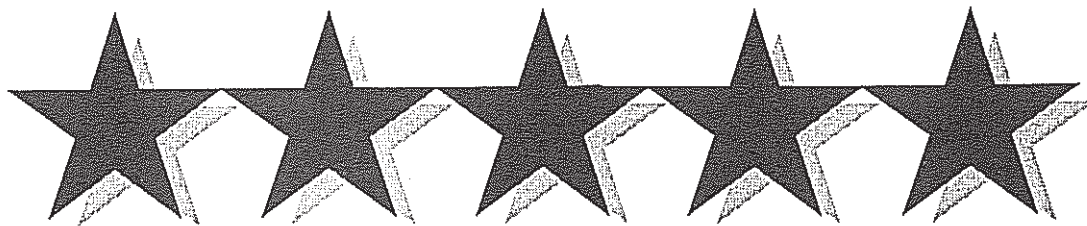

American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck 1994 American Legion Baseball Program will consist of three teams - the Governors, Royals, and Scarlets. Our goal in 1994 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The Governors, our "AA" varsity team, will play about a 60 game schedule. Post-season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Williston and the State Tournament in Dickinson.

North Dakota American Legion Baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season, each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The state champion then enters a Regional Tournament against South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, and Missouri Champions and a host team. The winner of that tournament advances to the American Legion World Series to determine the National Champion.

This season the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program will again sponsor two "B" teams - the Scarlets and Royals. The Scarlets will consist of about 16 players in the 15 and 16 year age bracket, and will play approximately 65 games. The Royals will carry about 16 players in the 14 to 16 year age bracket, and will play about 40 games. Practices begin the middle of May, with the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a District Tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day that games are not scheduled. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

We welcome any interested youth between 14 and 16 years of age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to

a high caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the two-team structure will allow any interested young man the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.

Historically, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program has been financed by the Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1, which donates a portion of the costs of the program. The Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1 and its Athletic Committee are particularly grateful for the money, services, and time donated by the many individuals, organizations, and businesses which is a vital part of funding this program.

The Program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the game of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program, along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsors the Bismarck Babe Ruth Program. Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop baseball skills to enable participants to become better players and fans.

The Babe Ruth League consists of young athletes who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Babe Ruth League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop their baseball skills.

Coaches for Babe Ruth League teams are people who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.

Coach Schroeder has 24+ years of teaching and coaching experience, nineteen of which were spent in Belfield. He was legion coach for the years 1968 and 1969 at New England, both of which were State Tournament entrants. He was head coach for Dickinson Legion in 1990 and 1991. Dickinson was a State entrant in '91. He also played 21 years of amateur baseball during the years 1966 through 1986.

Coach Schroeder and his wife Tammy are parents of two children, Dara age 13 and Sharona age 10.

This is coach Schroeder's third year as head coach of the Governors.
